A key component of this role is supporting clients in their physical, social, emotional, and daily life skills development and to enhance their quality of life with social, cultural and recreational activities.

The Youth Support Worker will ensure services are provided within the context of the client's care plan and respects the client's spirit, dignity and individuality.

**Requirements:**

- ***Successful candidates must be available to work evenings and weekends.***
- Preference will be given to persons from the nine-member Nations that make up Kw'umut Lelum.
- Two years of child and youth care, social work or equivalent combined with a minimum 1 year of work experience in the human or youth services field. This will include having knowledge of:
  - Child development;
  - Crisis management and de-escalation;
  - Behaviour intervention strategies.
- Experience working with First Nations communities is an asset.
- A valid driver's license is required.

The successful applicants must consent to criminal record and prior contact checks.
